midst of some late winter weather! For us, Furlough has been a wonderful time of not only meeting with the amazing pastors and churches that faithfully support us, but also catching up with all our precious family spread across the United States, and the many friends in the ministry who have remained faithful to our Lord through all the years! After finishing up in the Northeast, we turned south again (praise God), and I got to see and spend some time with my younger brother Paul in Norfolk, Virginia. It has been too long since I have been with him and Traci. Currently we are in South Carolina.



Our church in Cork, Ireland has been busy so far in 2017. Darlene E. has been attending Church for quite a while now, but just recently understood *her need* to believe the Gospel and gloriously got born again! The Church



folks also had a big part in this year's **Patrick's Day Parade**, with the theme of our float being **"Throw Out the Line-line"**. All the folks did a great job handing out Gospel tracts with lifesaver mints, and carrying huge Gospel signs and tee-shirts saying "*The Son of Man is come to seek and to save that which was lost*"! It was a great Gospel witness to the 15,000 onlookers! Our float even won an award for Best Presentation! Amen! Our church also is busy preparing for a big **nationwide Men's Camp** just after Resurrection Sunday.
