had to wait until September to get away due to all the Covid restrictions. So we finally took a trip to Greece where we got some sun and some needed rest! We gave out many Gospel tracts but

had none in Greek! Europe desperately needs the Gospel!



Continuing to Evangelize in Cork City. If there is one thing very frustrating about the Covid restrictions, it is evangelising. Almost everything we normally do to get the Gospel out is severely hindered, yet we make do with what we still have: Every Friday we talk face to face to dozens and dozens of men and women with the Gospel on the streets of downtown Cork City; every Friday and Sunday evening I

preach the Gospel while I play the old Gospel hymns on the local radio station; every day we have people who faithfully give out at least one Gospel tract to people they meet, without fail; and our church doors are open for preaching and Bible teaching every Sunday and Wednesday, and we have had well over 30 visitors to church over

the past few months! Amen!

Addictions Ministry. I am excited that our Twelve Weeks To Freedom from addictions course that we developed here is now being used in almost a dozen churches, and now even in Australia.
