Souls Saved recently! Three people have been born again recently, and none of them without great trials. **Jim O'C** comes from a very rough background, and was reached in January through our Reformer's Unanimous meetings! He has been faithful out to church on Sundays every week since! **Claire is from Mallow,** and was having some very rough marital problems (still is), but she knew her battles were more than emotional or marital – she knew she needed something more. My wife and I talked with her for almost 4 hours, and led her in prayer to surrender her life and problems over to the will of God, and to give her sins over to Jesus Christ! She did and was gloriously saved! I wish her "friends" would get saved, because THEY are making it very hard for her to live for God, and for her marriage to be restored! Please pray for her! **Philip** is a teenager who came out to the *Teen All-Nighter* that we had back in January. So sceptical and hard at first, but as more and more of his questions were answered from the Bible, he just melted. Bible Institute News. Early on Saturday mornings, 10 men and women gather in my sitting

room for some intense study of God's word, and preparation for the ministry. They all are so eager and hungry to know God's word and the principles to lead by. We cover three classes on a Saturday mornings, followed by soul-winning that afternoon, then Wednesday evening we study verse by verse through a Book of the Bible, and Sunday mornings and evenings they learn more Biblical truths geared to prepare not just the students, but everyone in the church for the ministry! Pray for them as labourers, because they are so needed!

Church In Mallow – For almost 10 years now I have been holding Sunday afternoon meetings and weekly Bible studies in the town of Mallow which is about 45 minutes north of our main church here in Ballincollig. I have run Summer Bible Clubs with almost 50 in attendance every year, and been door knocking and soul-winning for all those 10 years all with the goal of starting a second church there. I also taught weekly Discipleship to over 15 of the people who got saved in Mallow. Mallow is a spiritually dark town, like 90% of Ireland. But I just can't keep doing it all – not if I am pasturing the church in Ballincollig also. What Mallow needs is it's own missionary/pastor who will minister to them much more than I can. Please pray for us and for wisdom about this struggling church. Ireland needs more Gospel preaching churches!
